This test is to be used for student pilots to prepare for solo flight, i/a/w 61.87(b). This is an open book test. Please answer each question as completely as possible, and provide the source for each of your answers (i.e. FAR 91.3, 61.87, etc).

CFR Part 91

1. What preflight action is required of a pilot prior to a flight?
2. FAR 91.3 & 91.7 establish that the pilot-in-command is responsible for all operations of the aircraft. Does this apply to a student pilot?
3. You are preparing for departure on runway 4 in the runup area. During your runup, you inadvertently blow debris toward an aircraft behind you. Did you violate FAR 91.13?
4. No pilot may operate an aircraft within ___ hours of consuming any alcoholic beverage, or when their blood alcohol level exceeds ___.
5. You are preparing to back-taxi runway 31 for a northwest departure. There is an aircraft on the base leg for runway 31. Under FAR 91.113, what is the appropriate action?
6. The FAR's define the minimum safe altitude for flight over congested and non-congested areas (although it doesn't define "congested area"). What is the minimum safe altitude for a flight over Dewey Beach?

13. What are the weather minimums for student pilots prescribed in FAR 61.89(a)?

14. Under what circumstances are student pilots allowed to carry passengers?

15. List the student pilot endorsements required prior to a solo cross country flight?

16. The FAR's require 12 maneuvers and procedures to be completed before a student pilot may be signed off for a solo cross country?
